The Police (Inspector Jeanne Farrugia) vs Mogbolu Bright, son of John, born in Benin Citty, Nigeria on the 24<sup>th</sup> April, 1991, Police number 09B-087

The Court,

Having seen the charge proffered against the accused namely, that in April, 2011 as a person landing or embarking in or from Malta, failed to be in possession of a passport and failed to provide the Principal Immigration Officer the prescribed information and such other information that the Principal Immigration Officer may deem proper to require.

Having seen the note filed by the Attorney General whereby he gave his consent that this case be tried summarily. Informal Copy of Judgement

Having seen the records of the case of the 20<sup>th</sup> December, 2011 whereby the accused admitted to the charge as proffered.

Consequently, the Court finds the accused guilty of the charge as proffered. Having seen section 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta condemns him to a term of imprisonment of thirty-two (32) days.
