POLICE INSPECTOR GRAZIELLA MUSCAT VS ACCUSED OMISSES

The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against Accused omisses, omisses, born in omisses, on omisses, residing at omisses, holder of I.D. Card Number omisses;

Charged with having:

In the month of June 2011 and in the previous months in Rabat with having committed the same act even if at

different times, constituting violations of the same provision of the law, which were committed in pursuance of the same design, by having participated into sexual activity with minor Victim (minor) of 15 years of age.

Having heard the evidence tendered on oath;

Having seen the consent of the Attorney General and that of the accused for the case to be expedited with summary proceedings;

Having seen the guilty plea registered by the accused;

Having seen the confirmation of the guilty plea, registered by the accused, after the court accorded the accused a reasonable time for re consideration;

Having heard the oral submissions of the parties;

Deliberates:

Therefore the Court finds the accused **omisses** guilty as charged, and after having seen Article 204C, 28A and 28G, 412C of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, **condemns** the accused to a period of two (2) years imprisonment suspended for a period of four (4) years.

In addition, the Court is issuing a **Supervision Suspended Order against the accused, for a period of three (3) years**, under the supervision of the Director of Probation Services or any other Probation Officer so nominated.

In addition the Court orders the issue of a **Protection Order for a period of three (3) years** against the **accused omisses**, holder of I.D. Card Number omisses and in favour of the minor Victim (minor) and his family, Informal Copy of Judgement

whereby the Court prohibits the accused from contacting or molesting the same minor or members of his family, and this after taking into account all the considerations listed in Article 412C (4) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court orders that a copy of this judgement be notified to Director of Probation Services.

The Court, in according punishment, took into consideration the fact that the accused is a first offender, the fact that she pleaded guilty to all charges in the early stages of the proceedings, and in view of the fact that she is a single mother of two teenage girls.
