The Court, Having seen the charges profferred against the accused, namely, -

1. that on the 1st January, 2002 in Malta, forged, altered or tempered with, or used or had in his possession a certificate of identity issued by the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland bearing number CID 105282 issued on the 11th February, 2000 which he knew to be forged, altered or tempered with;

2. with having on the same date and circumstances received a passport transferred to him by any other person; The Court is requested that besides awarding the punishment according to Law declares the above mentioned person as a prohibited immigrant and issue a Removal Order against him.

Having seen the note filed by the Attorney General whereby he gave his consent that this case be dealt with summarily.

Having seen the records of the case of the 4th January, 2002 where the accused admitted to the charges.

Consequently, the Court finds him guilty of the charges profferred against him. Having seen articles 3(b) and 5 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta does not condemn him to a term of imprisonment but sets him free in terms of article 9 of Chapter 152 of the Laws of Malta on condition that he commits no other offence for a period of one year starting from today. Moreover, having seen article 15 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta declares him a prohibited immigrant and orders his removal from these Islands.
