**The Court,**

Having seen that the accused Alex Dudka holder of Polish Identity Card number ACV 402694.

Was charged with having:

1. On the 7<sup>th</sup> of January 2012 at about 15:30pm, whilst being in Sliema, committed theft aggravated by value, of several mobile phones which global value exceeds two

hundred and thirty-two euro and ninety-four cents (€232.94), to the detriment of Jonathan Pirota.

2. Further more during the same date, time, place and circumstances, knowingly received or purchased any property which has been stolen, misapplied or obtained by means of any offence, whether committed in Malta or abroad, which items' value exceeds two hundred and thirty-two euro and ninety-four cents (€232.94), or for knowingly take part, in any manner whatsoever, in the sale or disposal of these items.

3. Further more for having on the 25<sup>th</sup> February 2012, between 21:00pm and 22:00pm, with intent to commit theft, aggravated by time and value which exceeds, two hundred and thirty two Euros and ninety four cents (€232.94) to the detriment of Jonathan Pirota, manifested such intent by overt acts which were followed by a commencement of the execution of the crime, which crime was not completed due to some accidental cause independent of the his will.

Having heard examination of the accused whereby he pleaded guilty to the charges brought against him and confirmed such plea after given the faculty to reconsider his plea.

Therefore after having seen Articles 267, 279(a) and 334 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta finds him guilty of all charges and by virtue of Article 28A of Chapter 9 condemns him to eighteen (18) months imprisonment suspended for three (3) years.

Finally, explained in simple words the repercussions if said order is not abided with.
