## The Court,

Having seen that the accused known as Akate Adame Ali Abdul Karim without a fixed address or identification document.

Was charged with having on the 1<sup>st</sup> May 2012 and in the preceeding months in Malta:

1. without lawful authority used or had in his posession any document required for the purposes of the Immigration Act which is forged (Art 32 (1) (f) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta). Informal Copy of Judgement

2. made use or had in his possession any passport which he knew to be forged, altered or tampered with (Art 5 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta).

3. in relation to any information to be given under or for purposes of the Immigration Act, made or caused to be made any false return, false statement or false representation (Art 32 (1) (c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta).

Having heard admission plea of accused during the sitting of the 28<sup>th</sup> of May 2012, and confirmed such plea after being given the opportunity to reconsider such plea.

Therefore after seen Articles 17(h), 32(1) (f) and 32(1) (c) of Chapter 217 and Article 5 of Chapter 61 finds accused Akate Adame Ali Abdul Karim guilty of all charges against him and condemns him to one (1) month imprisonment.
