The Police (Ins. Anna Marie Micallef) vs Yanou Babo Ullin

The Court;

Having seen the accusations brought forward against **Yanou Babo Ullin** of 37 years, son of Augustin Yanou and Madeleine *nee*' Njinguet, born in Bangwa (Cameroon) on the 23rd August, 1975 and without a fixed address, holder of Cameroon Passport number 01527007, and accuse him;

With having on the 6th August 2012 and in the preceding months;

1. By several acts committed by him, even if at different times, which constitute violations of the same provision of the law, committed in pursuance of the same design, whilst in Malta, conspired with one or more persons in Malta or outside Malta for the purpose of committing a crime (the crime of Fraud as per Section 308, 309, 310 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta) in Malta;

The Court having seen the accusations being brought against the accused **Yanou Babo Ullin**;

Having heard his early admission to the accusation;

Having heard the parties confirming that the accused shall be leaving the Island tomorrow for which he has a flight ticket already issued;

In view of all the above and after hearing the parties submissions on the penalty to be inflicted;

Having seen Sections 308, 309 and 310 as well as Article 28A and Article 48A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

The court on his admission finds the accused guilty of the accusations being made against him and condemns the accused to a term of imprisonment of two (2) months from today which term shall not elapse unless the accused commits any other offence punishable with imprisonment within a term of four (4) years from today in terms of article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

The Court explained to the accused his obligations at law arising out of this judgement;

The Court orders that these acts be trasmitted to the attorney general within the time prescribed by law;

The Court also orders that the accused will be detained by the Immigration Authority and accompanied to the Airport for him to leave the Island tomorrow;

The Court orders the confiscation and destruction of the document exhibited by the Prosecution marked as document AMM1.
