#### POLICE INSPECTOR JOHANN J. FENECH VS MOHAMMED ALI YOUSUF NOUR

## The Court;

After seeing the charges brought against:

Mohammed Ali Yousuf Nour aged 22, son of Mohammed Ali and Aisa nee' Bayo, born in Somalia on the 1<sup>st</sup> January 1989, residing at an unknown address and holder of ID card no. 40981A;

With having in these islands during the night between the  $6^{th}$  and  $7^{th}$  October 2012 had in his possession the resin obtained formed the Plant Cannabis or any other

preparation of which such resin formed the base in terms of Section 8(a) of the Chapter 101 of Laws of Malta;

#### Considers:

After having seen the Articles 8(a) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta;

After having seen the accused admit the charges brought against him, which admission was confirmed by him after having been given due time to reconsider in accordance with the law;

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited;

After having heard the accused's plea and after having given the time prescribed by Law for the accused to consider his plea;

This Court finds the said accused guilty as charged but discharges him from any punishment on condition that he does not commit another offence within the period of six (6) months from today, in accordance with the provisions of Article 22 Chapter 446 of the Law of Malta.

The Court explained in clear words the terms of the judgement to the accused.
