The Court:

Having seen the accusations brought against the accused Mark David Jr. Jackman holder of British Passport GBR 540542432.

Accused that:

On the 29th day of September 2012, between 01.00a.m. and 02.00a.m. at St Julians:

Informal Copy of Judgement

1. Made injurious remarks, or threatened, or made a bodily offence on persons assigned according to law of a public service, whilst they were performing, or because they were performing this service, or with the intent of frightening or influencing them against the law in the execution of their duties;

2. And more that on the same date, locality, time and circumstances; by attacking, violently resisting, or by physically attacking, by any means that is not considered as public violence, persons responsible according to law of a public service, whilst they were acting in execution of the law or on an order given according to law by competent authorities;

3. And more that on the same date, locality, time and circumstances attacked Inspector Trevor Micallef and Police Sergeant 1187 Omar Zammit to distress them, hustle them or to cause them harm;

4. And more that on the same date, locality, time and circumstances; voluntarily infringed orderliness and Public Peace;

5. And more that on the same date, locality, time and circumstances; disobeyed legitimate orders given by competent authorities or by someone who is responsible from a public service;

6. And more that on the same date, locality, time and circumstances was drunk in such a manner that he could not restrain himself.

Read the documents;

Heard the evidence;

After having seen the Articles 95 (1), 96 (1), 339 (1) (d), 338 (dd), 338 (ee) and 338 (ff) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Informal Copy of Judgement

The Court has decided to apply Article 28 A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, that of suspended sentence for imprisonment of six (6) months for one (1) year.

The Court explained the consequences of the judgement to the accused.
