The Court

Having seen the charges against Ivelin Blagoev Krasten, 25 years, son of Bwagoe and the late Stefka nee Sawova, born in Bulgaria on the 3rd April 1987, residing at Aster Flats, Flat 2, Sir George Borg Street Sliema and holder of Bulgarian identity card number 196441367 and Maltese identity card bearing no: 65985(A).

Charged with having on these Islands, on the 15th of December 2012 and in the preceeding months had in his

possession the whole or any portion of the plant Cannabis in terms of Section 8(d) of the Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta.

In the case of guilt the Court is also being requested to apply the provisions of article 533(1) of Chapter 9 Laws of Malta.

Having seen section 8(d) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen the Order of the Attorney General for this case to be tried summarily.

Having seen that the accused admitted the charges brought against him and confirmed his admission of guilt even after having been given sufficient time to reconsider his plea.

Having seen the acts of the proceedings.

Having considered

That defendant admitted the charge brought against him; this is consequently sufficiently proved.

With regards to the penalty to be meted out the Court considered the nature of the offence of which the defendant is being found guilty, and the circumstances in which he was found to have the substance in question in his possession.

Wherefore the Court, after having seen section 8(d) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta, on his admission finds defendant guilty of the charge brought against him and by application of section 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta discharges him on condition that he does not commit an other offence in the period of a year.

The Court explained to the defendant in ordinary language the significance of this judgement and of the
