VS

AMINATA SOW

The Court,

Seen the charges brought against Aminata Sow of 22 years, daughter of unknown father and mother, born on the 03/05/1990 born in Senegal. Holder of unknown documents. Unknown address.

Was charged for having:

On the 25th August 2012, previous dates in Malta, made use or caused to be made a false return, false statement

or false representation and/or furnished the Principal Immigration Officer with false information, and this in violation of Article 32 (1c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

And also under the same circumstances, for having committed any other kind of forgery, or knowingly made use of any other forged document, and this in violation of Article 183, 184 and 189 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

And also under the same circumstances, for having refused to give, or untruthfully given to any public officer or any other person entrusted with a public service in the actual exercise of his/her duties, his/her name, surname, address and other particulars, and this in violation of Article 338 (g) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

And also under the same circumstances, for having had an identity card in her possession, issued by Malta with the name of ADAMA MOUNA with number 76382 A, and this in violation of Article 12 (1) of Chapter 258 of the Laws of Malta.

Heard evidence.

Seen the acts of the Case and exhibited documents.

Seen the articles sent by the Attorney General in his Note dated the 4th day of October, 2012 and noted that accused has no objection that the Case be heard summarily.

Noted that in today's Sitting Dr. Mark Mifsud Cutajar for accused informed the Court that at this stage accused was declaring that she was pleading guilty to the charges brought against her.

When asked by the Court accused said she was pleading guilty to all the charges brought against her.

The Court warned accused in the most solemn manner as to her plea of guilt and gave her time to consider her plea.

When accused was asked again if she confirms her plea of guilt or not accused replied that she was pleading guilty of all the charges brought against her.

Heard submissions on punishment.

Seen Section 32(1c) of Chapter 217, Sections 17, 183, 184, 189 and 338(g) of Chapter 9 and Section 12(1) of Chapter 258 of the Laws of Malta.

Finds accused Aminata Sow, on admission of guilt, guilty of all the charges brought against her, taking into consideration all the circumstances of the Case and having seen Sections 28A and 28B of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta condemns accused Aminata Sow to two (2) years imprisonment and orders that this Sentence as regards the punishment of imprisonment shall not take effect unless during the period of four (4) years as from today accused Aminata Sow commits another offence punishable with imprisonment.

Finally the Court is giving accused Aminata Sow the explanation prescribed in sub-section 28A(4) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.
