vs

Jeremie Camilleri

The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accused, holder of identity card number 481611L, charged with on these islands on the 11<sup>th</sup> June, 2012, at about 0830hrs in Main Street, Lija:

1. caused voluntary damages of around 900 Euros, to the detriment of Sharonne Fenech.

2. For having on the same date, place and circumstances without intent to steal or to cause any

wrongful damage, but only in the exercise of a pretended right, shall, of his own authority, disturbed the possession of anything enjoyed by Sharonne Fenech, or in any other manner unlawfully interfere with the property of another person.

In case of guilt the Court is requested to cause Jeremie Camilleri to pay the injured parties that amount to cover expenses which is established by the Court for the damages incurred from the crime committed.

Having seen the Attorney General's consent that the case be heard summarily.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges on which he insisted after having been given time to reconsider.

Having seen all the acts and documents.

Having seen Articles 325(b), 85 and 17(h) of the Criminal Code condemns him to one year imprisonment suspended for one year by application of Article 28A of Chapter 9.

Upon application of Article 28H of same Chapter 9 condemns him to pay the injured party 115 Euros within three months from today.
