-vs-

Marya Ali Mohamed Samira Ali

The Court,

Having seen that the accused Marya Ali Mohamed known with police number 12H-044 and Samira Ali known with police number 12H-041.

Were charged with having:

On the 16th January 2012, in these islands forged, altered or tampered with Passports, and Residence Permit Cards or used or had in their possession Passports, and Informal Copy of Judgement

Residence Permit Cards which they knew to be forged, altered or tampered with, in the name of Sahra Abdi Ali bearing numbers 060231, and Q450122 respectively, and in the name of Samira Hassan Ali bearing numbers 060233, and Q450098 respectively (Cap. 61, Sec 5 of the Laws of Malta);

And also with having on the same date, time and circumstances committed any other kind of forgery, or have knowingly made use of any other forged document, in the mentioned documents (Cap. 9, Sec 189 of the Laws of Malta); and

Also with having on the same date, time and circumstances forged any document or true copy of a document or an entry made in pursuance of this act (Cap. 217, Sec 32(1d) of the Laws of Malta).

After hearing the examination of both the accused whereby they admitted to all charges brought against them and the confirmation of such plea after being given the opportunity to reconsider their plea; and

Seen all evidence tendered by the prosecution.

Therefore by virtue of Article 5 of Chapter 61, Article 189 of the Criminal Code and Article 32(1d) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta, finds accused Marya Ali Mohamed and Samira Ali guilty of all the charges brought against them and condemns them to six (6) months each imprisonment.
