VS

JORDAN WELLS aged 19 years, son of Dean and Ann nee' Bennett, born in Birmingham, United Kingdom, on the 4th December, 1992, residing at 152, Villa Carina, Triq is-Sirk, Swieqi, holder of identity card number 49057A;

The Court;

Having seen charged proffered against the abovementioned **Jordan Wells** who was accused of having:

On the night between the 15th and 16th August 2012, and during the previous days, on these Islands:

Had in his possession the psychotropic and restricted drug (ecstasy) without a special authorisation in writing by the Superintendent of Public Health, in breach of the provisions of the Medical and Kindred Professions Ordinance Chap 31 of the Laws of Malta and the Drugs (Control) Regulations, Legal Notice 22 of 1985 as amended.

Having seen accused's early guilty plea at this stage of his arraignment, and this after having been allowed due time by Court to re-consider same.

Having seen Attorney General's consent for summary proceedings, to which accused declared that he had no objection.

Seen records of the case.

Considered:

That on admissions Court find accused guilty as charged, and this after having seen Chapter 31 of the Laws of Malta; and LN 22/1985, and condemns him to a conditional discharge for a period of one year (1) and this in terms of Section 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.

Orders the destruction of pills exhibited having exhibit number KB301.2012.
