VS

Lucky Opia

The Court,

Having seen that the accused Lucky Opia, holder of Identity card number 55952(A).

Was charged:

With having on the 20th January 2013 at around 00:15a.m. in these Islands assaulted or resisted by violence or active force not amounting to public violence, persons lawfully charged with a public duty when in the execution of the law or of a lawful order issued by a competent authority;

On the same date, time and circumstances disobeyed the lawful orders of any authority or of any person entrusted with a public service, or hinders or obstructs such person in the exercise of his duties, or otherwise unduly interfered with the exercise of such duties, either by preventing other persons from doing what they are lawfully enjoined or allowed to do, or frustrating of undoing what has been lawfully done by other persons;

On the same date, time and circumstances, willfully committed any spoil, damage or injury to or upon any movable or immovable property belonging to the government of Malta which damages exceeds one hundred and sixteen Euro and forty seven cents;

On the 19th January 2013 at around 21:00 hrs caused slight injuries on the person of Bright Nkemijijka Ezenwaoke.

On the 19th January 2013 at around 21:00 attempted to use force against Alexandra Scerri with intent to insult, annoy or hurt such person or others.

On the same date, time and circumstances, disturbed the public good order or the public peace;

The court is being requested to provide for the safety and security of Alexandra Scerri and Bright Nkemjika Ezenwaoke in terms of Art 412C of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Finally the court is requested to deal with the accused as a recidivist.

Having heard examination of the accused whereby he pleaded guilty to the charges brought against him and confirmed such plea after given the faculty to reconsider their plea. Informal Copy of Judgement

After having seen articles 96, 338(ee), 325(1)(b), 221(1), 339 (1)(d), 338(dd), 49 and 50 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, finds accused Lucky Opia guilty of all the charges brought against him and since fifth charge was withdrawn and since charges two (2) and six (6) are absorbed in the others since they are contraventional, condemns him to a period of nine (9) months imprisonment.
