The Court,

After having seen the charges brought against the accused:

1. ***Gajic Miroljub***, 27 years, son of Milan and Vidosava, born in Serbia on the 1st May 1974 and holder of passport number 002864594, of Yugoslav nationality;

2. *Savic Drgoslav*, 32 years old, son of Miliboie and Imilessa, born in Serbia on the 24th July 1967 and holder of passport number 001646918, of Yugoslav nationality;

For having during the past months, without having been granted a residence permit, landed or were in Malta without leave from the Principal Immigration Officer.

Having seen that during today`s sitting the accused admitted the charges.

Finds the accused guilty

Having seen Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta and Section 28A of Chapter 9 ;

Decides to apply the last mentioned section in virtue of the clean conduct of the accused.

Condemns accused to **six (6) months imprisonment which sentence shall not come into effect unless**

accused commits another crime subject to imprisonment within one (1) year from today.

Having seen the prosecution`s request in terms of Section 14 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta, grants the said request, **declares the accused a prohibited immigrant and orders the issue of a removal order against them.**
