Lacramioara Ciurar Armeanca Caldarar

The Court;

Having seen the charges brought against:

**Lacramioara Ciurar** 26 years of age, daughter of Nestor and Margareta *nee*' Ciurar born in Mun Fagaras in Romania on the 11<sup>th</sup> November 1986, holder of Romanian identity card number 643624 and residing at Charlie's Guest House Flat 7, Valley Road, Msida; Informal Copy of Judgement

**Armeanca Caldarar** 18 years of age, daughter of Nikolai and Theresa *nee*' Caldarar born in Mun Fagaras in Romania on the 3<sup>rd</sup> June 1994, holder of Romanian identity card number 827000 and residing at Charlie's Guest House Flat 7, Valley Road, Msida;

With having on the 20<sup>th</sup> of February 2013, in these Islands, by means of an unlawful practice, or by the use of any ficticious name, or the assumption of any false designation, or by means of any other deceit, device or pretence calculated to lead to the belief in the existence of any ficticious enterprise or of any imaginary power, influence or credit, or to create the expectation or apprehension of any chimerical event, made a profit by deceit of more than two hundred and thirty three euros and ninety three cents, however not more than two thousand and three hundred and twenty nine euros and thirty seven cents to the detriment of a number of people;

Having heard the plea of guilt;

Having seen the records of the case;

Finds the accused guilty as charged;

Having seen articles 308 Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

Codemns the accused to a term of imprisonment of seven (7) months from today which term shall not elapse unless the accused commit another offence punishable with imprisonment withih two (2) years from today and this in terms of article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

The Court explained to the accused their obligations arising out of this judgement.

The Court also orders that these acts be transmitted to the attorney general according to law since the prosecution did not have the consent of the attorney general for this case to be tried summarily.
