LIU RENHUA YU YALI QIN WEIHONG

The Court,

Seen the charge brought against Liu Renhua, 42 years, d/o Liu Qinghe and Zhang Guimei, born Jilin China on the 11th May 1971, residing at Attard and holder of Chinese Passport number G37233606

And

Yu Yali, 43 years, d/o Yu Dian Lu and Wang Wei Feng, born Anshan China on the 18th December 1969, residing at Attard and holder of Chinese Passport number G55298615

And

Qin Weihong, 44 years, d/o Qin Youqu and Liao Chong Zhang, born Changsha China on the 30th December 1968, residence unknown and holder of Chinese Passport number G25694234

And charge them with having on the 3 February 2013 and in the preceding months, on these Islands, by several acts committed by them, even if at different times, which constitute violations of the same provision of the law, committed in pursuance of the same design:

1) Kept or managed or shared with others in the management of a brothel or of any house, shop or other premises or any part thereof which is or are, or is or are reputed to be resorted to for the purpose of prostitution or other immoral purposes.

Heard evidence.

Seen the acts of the Case and exhibited documents.

Seen the Attorney General's Consent marked as Doc CLP1 and noted that all accused have no objection that their case be dealt with summarily.

Noted that in today's Sitting all the accused through the Court appointed interpreter declared that they do not need the assistance of a lawyer and having been asked again by the Court whether they need the assistance of a lawyer they confirmed that they do not need to be assisted by a lawyer. At this stage of the proceedings all the accused through the Court appointed interpreter pleaded guilty to the charge brought against them.

The Court warned all the accused in the most solemn as to consequences of their admission of guilt and gave them some time to decide whether to confirm their admission of guilt or not, and having been asked whether they confirm their admission of guilt or not, all the accused confirmed through the Court appointed interpreter that they are pleading guilty to the charge brought against them.

Seen Section 18 of Chapter 9 and Section 8(1) of Chapter 63 of the Laws of Malta.

Finds accused Liu Renhua, Yu Yali and Qin Weihong, on admission of guilt, guilty of the charge brought against them, taking into consideration all the circumstances of the case including the clean conduct sheet of each accused and having seen Section 28A and 28B of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta condemns accused Liu Renhua, Yu Yali and Qin Weihong to two (2) years imprisonment each and one hundred Euro (Euro 100) each and orders that this Sentence as regards the punishment of imprisonment shall not take effect unless during the period of three (3) years as from today the said accused commit another offence punishable with imprisonment.

Finally the Court is giving accused Liu Renhua, Yu Yali and Qin Weihong, through the Court appointed interpreter, the explanation prescribed in the sub-section 28A(4) of Chapther 9 of the Laws of Malta.
