The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accused holder of Immigration Police number 08BBBB-113, charged for having in 2010, later months in Malta, landed or embarked from Malta without being in possession of a passport and have not furnished to the Principal Immigration Officer the prescribed information and such other information as the Principal Immigration Officer may deem proper to require, an this in violation of Article 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta. Informal Copy of Judgement

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges on which plea he insisted even after the Court allowed him time to reconsider.

Having seen all the acts and records of the proceedings.

On accused voluntary and unconditional plea of guilt declares and finds him guilty of the charges proffered against him.

Having seen Articles 28 and 32 of Chapter 217.

Decides: to acquit him on condition that accused does not commit a further offence within three years from today on application of Article 22 of Chapter 446.

The Court explained to accused his responsibilities according to the judgment.
