The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against **Helen Katrina Milligan**, daughter of Peter and Betty, born in United Kingdom on the 15th March 1973, residing at Cini Apartments, Flat 2, Church Street, Ghasri, Gozo, holder of Maltese identity card number 24196(A), charged with

having on the 4th December 2012 during the Court sitting at the Gozo Law Courts, Victoria, Gozo:

1. with the intent to destroy or damage the reputation of Anthony Xuereb I.D. 36966(G), offended such person by words or gestures or any other matter where such defamation consisted in vague expressions or indeterminate reproaches, or in words or acts which are merely indecent;

2. for having uttered insults or threats to the person of Anthony Xuereb I.D. 36966(G).

Having heard the evidence produced.

Considers

That from the evidence produced, the Court is convinced that the accused actually used the word "sick" with reference to Anthony Xuereb. Hence the first (1st) charge brought against the accused has been sufficiently proven. The same cannot be said regarding the second (2nd.) charge brought against the accused.

Therefore, the Court, whilst acquitting the accused from the second $(2^{nd}.)$ charge brought against her, after having seen and considered Section 252(1) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, finds the accused guilty of the first $(1^{st}.)$ charge brought against her and condemns her to a fine (multa) of one hundred Euros (€100.00).
