Today, the 2<sup>nd</sup> of June, 2013

The Court,

Having seen that the accused known as Mikolai Bartolomiej, holder of identity card number 72633A Was accused with having:

a) In these islands on the 1<sup>st</sup> of June, 2013 and in the previous months before this date had in his possession the resin obtained from the plant Cannabis, or

any other preparation of which such resin formed the base, in terms of Section 8 (a) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta.

After having seen the guilty plea by the accused to the charge brought against him, and the confirmation of such plea after being given the opportunity to reconsider his position;

And seen Article 8(a) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta, finds accused Mikolaj Bartlomiej guilty the charge brought against him and by virtue of Article 22 of Chapter 446 frees him on condition that he does not commit another offence within eight (8) months from today.

Finally, explained in simple words the repercussions if such order is not complied with and orders the destruction of the drug presented in court and marked as Dok JS1.
