Fatemeh Sahami

The Court,

Having seen that the accused Fatemah Sahami holder of Iranian passport M25990965.

Was charged:

1. with having on the 17th June, 2013 in these islands forged, altered or tampered with a Passport, or used or had in her possession a Passport, which she knew was forged, altered or tampered with, in the name of Signe Lillegaard Haldgrn bearing number 205334840 (Cap 61, Sec 5 of the Laws of Malta);

2. with having on the same date, time and circumstances committed any other kind of forgery, or have knowingly made use of any other forged document, in the mentioned documents (Cap 9, Sec 189 of the Laws of Malta;

3. with having on the same date, time and circumstances forged any document or true copy of a document or an entry made in pursuance of this act (Cap 217, Sec 32 (1d) of the Laws of Malta).

After seeing the guilty plea of accused, and the confirmation of such plea after being given the opportunity to reconsider her plea; and

After seeing that she is going to be repatriated today for her country of origin.

By virtue of Article 5 of Chapter 61, Article 189 of Chapter 9 and Article 32(1)(d) of Chapter 217 finds accused Fatemeh Sahamir guilty of all charges brought against her and by virtue of Article 28A of Chapter 9 condemns her to seven (7) months imprisonment suspended for one (1) year.

Finally, explained in simple words the repercussions if such order is not complied with.
