Khadija Mohamed Elmi

The Court,

Having seen that the accused Khadija Mohamed Elmi, holder of identity card number 79444A.

Was charged with having:

On the 5th October 2012, in Malta, made use or attempted to make use of a passport issued to another person in violation of Article 4 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta; and

Informal Copy of Judgement

Also with having on the same date, time and circumstances made a false return, a false statement or a false representation to the Principle Immigration Officer in violation of Article 32(1) c of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

After hearing admission plea by the accused to the charges brought against her, and the confirmation of such plea after being given the opportunity to reconsider her position;

After seeing that the accused has a baby who has special needs and that they are going to be relocated elsewhere; and

After having seen Article 4 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta and Article 32(1) c of Chapter 217 of the Laws Malta, finds accused Khadija Mohamed Elmi guilty of the charges brought against her and by virtue of Article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, condemns her to eight (8) months imprisonment suspended for a year.

Finally, explained in simple words the repercussions if such order is not abided with.
