INSPECTOR GABRIEL MICALLEF VS LIAM PATRICK HODGE

The Court;

After seeing the charges brought against:

Liam Patrick Hodge of 30 years, son of John and Jennifer nee' King, born UK on the 21st September 1982, residing at no. 12 Rose Markiz Bugeja Street, St Paul's Bay and holder of identity card number 63450A;

With having on the 17^{th} July 2013 between 01.50hrs and 02.25hrs from the Black and White Club in St Pauls' Bay, committed theft of two bags, 2 mobile phones and \in 20 in cash, which theft is aggravated by time;

After having seen the Articles 261, 270 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

After having seen the accused admit the charges brought against him, which admission was confirmed by him after having been given due time to reconsider in accordance with the law;

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited;

After having heard that the accused had repaid in full the amount so stolen, and had returned the rest of the goods;

After having heard the accused's plea and after having given the time prescribed by Law for the accused to consider his plea, this Court finds the said accused guilty as charged and discharges him from any punishment on condition that he does not commit any charges within the period of six (6) month in accordance with the provision of Article 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court explained in clear words the terms of the judgement to the accused.
