THE POLICE INSPECTOR EDEL MARY CAMILLERI

VS

MAHMOUD MOHAMMED RAUDA

The Court:

Having seen the accusations brought against the accused Mahmoud Mohammed Rauda, holder of Immigration Police Number 12V-024.

Accused that:

On the 1st and 2nd June 2013, days later and previous months in Malta, made use or caused to be made a false return, false statement or false representation and /or furnished the Principal Immigration Officer with false

information, and this in violation of Article 32 (1c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

And also under the same circumstances, for having committed any other kind of forgery, or knowingly made use of any other forged duocument, and this in violation of Article 183, 184 and 189 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

And also under the same circumstances, for having refused to give, or untruthfully given to any public officer or any other person entrusted with a public service in the actual exercise of his/her duties, his/her name, surname, address and other particulars, and this in violation of Article 338 (g) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Read the documents and accusations;

The Court having heard the Prosecuting Officer read out the accusations brought against the accused under oath;

Having heard the Prosecuting Officer after re-examination of the case withdraws charge number two (2) brought against the accused;

Having heard the accused pleads guilty to the first and the third charges brought against her by the Prosecuting Officer;

Heard Inspector Mary Edel Camilleri inform the Court that the accused had cooperated with the pertinent authorities;

After having seen Article 32 (1c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta; Article 183, 184 and 189 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta and Article 338 (g) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

The Court finds the accused guilty of the charges one (1) and three (3) also in view of her plead of guilt;

Sentences the accused Mahmoud Mohammed Rauda according to Article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta

and condemns her to one (1) year imprisonment which shall only become effective if accused commits another crime punishable by imprisonment during a period of (2) years as from today.

The Court explained the consequences of the judgement to the accused.
