VS

HASSAN SAID ALY AAYISH

The Court:

Having seen the accusations brought against the accused Hassan Said Aly Aayish, holder of Police Number 08XXX-046.

Accused that:

On the 6th February, 2009, escaped from a place of public custody that is Safi Detention Centre;

In a date not known in February, 2009, as a person landing or embarking in or from Malta, failed to be in

possession of a passport and failed to provide the Principal Immigration Officer the prescribed information and such other information that the Principal Immigration Officer may deem proper to require.

The Court:

Read the documents and accusations;

Heard the evidence produced under oath;

After having seen Section 151, 152 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta and Section 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court finds the accused Hassan Said Aly Aayish of all the charges brought against him by the Prosecution and according to Article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta condemns him for six (6) months imprisonment which shall become effective only if the accused commits another crime punishable by imprisonment during a period of two (2) years as from today.

The Court explained the consequences of the judgement to the accused.
