## VS

Zoran Stojanovic, 50 years, Serbian National, son of Borislav and Kosovka nee' Avramovic, born in Nis, Serbia, on the 9<sup>th</sup> December, 1963, who resides at Bastion View, Flat 7, The Strand, Sliema, holder of Serbian passaport number 002338411;

The Court;

Having seen charges brought against the abovementioned Zoran Stojanovic who who was charged of having:

On the 20<sup>th</sup> December, 2013 in these Islands, forged, altered, or tampered with a passport, or used or had in his possession a passport which hew know to be forged,

altered or tampered with (Chap 61, Sec 5 of the Laws of Malta);

Also of having on same date, time and circumstances committed any other kind of forgery, or have knowingly made use of any other forged document, in the mentioned documents (Chap 9, Sec 289 of the Laws of Malta)

Also of having on same date, time and circumstances, used or had in possession any document required for the purpose of the Immigration Act which is forged (Chap 217, Sec 32(1f) of the Laws of Malta)

Seen accused's guilty plea at the stage of his arraignment, which he confirmed after been allowed due time by Court to re-consider same.

Seen Section 5 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta; Section 189 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta; Section 32 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta; and also Section 17 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Considers:

After taking into consideration accused's guilty plea, Court finds accused guilty as charged, and condemns him to a term of effective imprisonment of eight (8) months.

Recommends Director of Prisons that accused be immediately examined due to current heart problems as exposed by Defence counsel in open Court.
