Doskovic Bojan

After having seen the charges brought against **Doskovic Bojan**, son of Bogosav and Zorica neé Bogicevic, born in Serbia on the 13th. March 1985 and residing at an unknown address in Bugibba, Malta, and holder of Serbian Passport 011217250 charged with having:

1. on the 7th. January 2014 and 8th. January 2014 whilst inside "Park Towers Supermarket" located in George Borg Olivier Street, Saint Julians committed theft of several items, which theft is aggravated by value which exceeds two hundred and thirty-two Euros and ninety-four cents (€ 232.94) but does not exceed two thousand, three hundred and twenty-nine Euros and thirty-seven cents (€ 2329.37)

to the detriment of the owners of “Park Towers Supermarket”, Daniela Pantalleresco and/or other persons.

Having examined all the documents forming part of the proceedings.

Having seen that the Attorney General gave his consent for this case to be tried summarily.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges brought against him, notwithstanding the fact that the Court in terms of Section 453(1) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta warned him in the most solemn manner of the legal consequences of his guilty plea after having given him sufficient time within which to reconsider and withdraw his guilty plea.

Considers

That, as a consequence of the admission of the accused of the charges brought against him, the Court finds the accused guilty of the said charges.

With regards to the punishment to be inflicted, the Court will be taking into consideration various factors, including the nature of the charges brought against the accused, the clean conviction sheet of the accused, his guilty plea at an early stage of these proceedings, the fact that the value of the objects stolen amounts to € 340.00 and the fact that the accused co-operated fully with the Police.

Therefore, the Court, after having seen and considered Sections 261(c), 267 and 279 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, finds the accused guilty of the charges brought against him, and in terms of Section 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta the Court is conditionally discharging the accused subject to the condition that he does not commit another offence within a period of three (3) years from date of this judgement and orders that within a period of one (1) month the accused pays the sum of

three hundred and forty Euros (€ 340.00) to the owners of “Park Towers Supermarket”, Daniela Pantalleresco.

In terms of Section 22(3) of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta the Court explained to the accused in ordinary language what are the consequences if he commits another offence during the said period of three (3) years from date of this judgement or if he fails to pay the amount of € 340.00 within a period of one (1) month.
