## **JESUS MANUEL MORENO HURTADO**

The Court,

Seen the charges brought against Jesus Manuel Moreno Hurtado, 26 years, son of Raffael and Immaculata nee' Moreno, born in Spain on 20/10/1987, residing at La Vallette Resort, Room Number 5037, Triq id-Dragunara, San Giljan and holder of Spanish Identity Card **76423143P**.

He was charged with having on the 28<sup>th</sup> of January 2014, whilst being on these Islands:

- 1. With intent to commit a crime, that was, without intent to kill or to put the life of any person in manifest jeopardy, tried to commit grievous bodily harm to the detriment of Daniela Cammarata, manifested such intent by overt acts which were followed by a commencement of the execution of the crime which crime was not completed in consequence of some accidental cause independent of the will of the offender in breach of Article 41(a), Article 216 of Chapter 9 of the laws of Malta.
- 2. Further more with having on the same date, time, place and circumstances committed slight bodily harm to the detriment of Daniela Cammarata in breach of Article 221 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta
- 3. Further more, with having on the same date, time, place and circumstances, wilfully disturbed the public good order or the public peace in breach of Article 338(m) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;
- 4. Further with having on the same date, time, place and circumstances uttered insults or threats towards Daniela Cammarata in breach of Article 229(1) (e) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

Seen the acts of the Case and the exhibited documents.

Seen the Attorney General's Consent exhibited as Doc TS and noted that accused, after having been asked by the Court whether he has any objection that the Case be heard summarily, and after having been given reasonable time to reply, declared that he has no objection that his Case be dealt with summarily.

Noted that in today's Sitting accused pleaded guilty to all the charges brought against him.

The Court warned accused in the most solemn manner as to the consequences of his admission of guilt and gave him some time to decide whether to confirm his admission of guilt or not, and having been asked whether he confirms his admission of guilt or not, accused confirmed that he is pleading guilty to all the charges brought against him.

Heard submissions on punishment.

Seen Sections 17, 41(1) (a), 216, 221, 339(1) (e) and 338(dd) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Taking into consideration that accused Jesus Manuel Moreno Hurtado pleaded guilty to all the charges brought against him, the Court has no alternative but to find said accused guilty of all the charges brought against him and having considered all the circumstances of the Case conditionally discharges accused Jesus Manuel Moreno Hurtado under the Provision of Section 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta on condition that said accused Jesus Manuel Moreno Hurtado commits no offence during the period of two (2) years as from today.

Moreover the Court, by applying Section 383 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, binds accused Jesus Manuel Moreno Hurtado with a personal guarantee of eight hundred Euro (Euro 800) to keep peace with Daniela Cammarata for a period of one year as from today.

Finally the Court is giving accused Jesus Manuel Moreno Hurtado the explanation prescribed in Sub-Section 22(3) of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.
