The Court

Having seen the charges laid against the accused, born in Iran on the 21st July 1977 and residing No 24, Saman Ave, Javad, St Emaili, Tehran, Iran

Charged with having on the 6th January 2014 in these Islands or anywhere else, forged, altered or tampered with a passport or used or had in his possession a forged Isreali passport, which he knew to be forged, altered or tampered with, bearing passport numbers 18054393 (Chap 61 Sec 5 of the Laws of Malta)

## Informal Copy of Judgement

Charged also for having on the same date, time and circumstances, committed any other kind of forgery or have knowingly made use of any other forged document, in the mentioned documents, (Chapter 9, Sec 189 of the Laws of Malta)

Charged also with having on the same date, time and circumstances forged any document or true copy of a document or an entry made in pursuance of this act (Chapter 217 Sect 21 (1d) of the Laws of Malta).

Having seen the Attorney General's consent that the case be heard summarily;

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges on which plea of guilt he insisted even after the Court gave him time to reconsider;

The facts are those outlined in the charge sheet supplemented by the accused's statement;

Decides, after declaring the accused guilty on his volontary and unconditional admission, and after having seen Article 5 of Chapter 61, Articles 189 and 17 of Chapter 9 and Article 32(1)(d) of Chapter 217 to condemn him to two years imprisonment which by application of Article 28A of Chapter 9 suspends them for a period of four years.

The Court has explained accused's responsibilities according to the judgement.
