KINAAN ABDINASIR NOOR

The Court:

Having seen the accusations brought against the accused Kinnan Abdinasir Noor, holder of Maltese Identity card number 82501A.

Accused that:

In Floriana, on the 24th August, 2013, at about 14:30hrs;

- Caused harm which is deemed to be grievous on the person of Mohamed Ali Mohamed (police number 13J-29), as certified by Dr. Maria Callus MD (Med. Reg. 3343) of Floriana Health Centre which grievous bodily harm was committed with arms proper, or with cutting or pointed instrument;
- 2. Wilfully committed any spoil, or damage upon any movable or immovable property, this property being vehicle Piaggio Porter, bearing vehicle registration number AAR 569 to the detriment of Raymond Abela and on vehicle Volkswagen Polo, bearing vehicle registration number EBC 258 to the detriment of Gillian Micallef, which damages do not exceed one thousand and one hundred and sixty four euro and sixty nine cents (€1,116.47) but exceeds one hundred and sixty euro and forty seven cents (€164.69);
- 3. Wilfully disturbed the public good order or the public peace;
- 4. Committed a crime punishable by imprisonment, whilst under an operational period of a sentence of two (2) years imprisonment suspended for four (4) years, handed by Magistrate Dr. S. Demicoli, LL.D., on the 19th August, 2013;
- 5. Accused also of being recidivist by means of a sentence handed to him by the Magistrate's Court of Malta, which sentence is definite and cannot be changed, in terms of Articles 49 and 50 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court:

Read the documents and accusations;

Heard the evidence produced under oath;

After having seen Article 216, 217, 325 (b) and 338 (dd) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

The Court after taking in consideration the admission of the accused and has heard the final brief of the parties and also the cooperation of the accused to the Prosecution including also the period he already spent in preventive custody as well as the fact that the accused was in contravention of a suspended sentence previously inflicted upon him;

The Court explained the consequences of the judgement to the accused.
