The Court,

Having seen the charges laid against the accused, holder of Maltese passport number 9011550;

Charged with having on the 21st February 2014 at about 08.00am and during the previous hours, days and weeks, whilst in St Julians and in these Islands:

## Informal Copy of Judgement

1. Committed forgery of any authentic and public instrument or of any commercial document or private bank document, by counterfeiting or altering the writing or signature, by feigning any fictitious agreement, disposition, obligation or discharge or by the insertion of any such agreement, disposition, obligation or discharge in any of the said instruments or documents after the formation thereof, or by any addition to or alteration of any clause, declaration or fact which such instruments or documents were intended to contain or prove, in breach of Article 183 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta

2. Furthermore, with having on the same date, time, place and circumstances, knowingly made use of any false act, writing, instrument or document, in breach of Article 184 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta

3. Furthermore with having on the same date, time, place and circumstance, in order to gain any advantage or benefit for himself or others, in any documents intended for any public authority, knowingly made a false declaration or statement, or gave false information, in breach of Article 188 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

4. Furthermore with having on the same date, time, place and circumstances, made to the prejudice of any other person or entity, made any other fraudulent gain, in breach of Article 309 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges brought against him on which plea the accused insisted even after being given time to reconsider.

From the acts of the proceedings it clearly transpires that the accused was in possession of a forged bus ticket, which he knew to be forged.

Having seen Article 189 of Chapter 9 decides to acquit the accused by applications of Article 22 of Chapter 446 for a period of three years from today.

The court explained to the accused his responsibilities according to the judgement.
