The Court,

Informal Copy of Judgement

Having seen that the accused Nicola Vulenic, holder of Serbian Passport 10685735;

Was charged with having on the 4<sup>th</sup> of June 2014, at around 04.10 hrs in Dragunara Rd, St Julian's and in the vicinities:-

- Committed theft of two mobile phones and a computer tablet, which theft exceeds two hundred and thirty Euro and ninety four cents (232.94) but does not exceed two thousand and three hundred and twenty-nine Euros and thirty seven cents (2,329.37 Euro), which theft is aggravated by 'amount' and 'time' to the detriment of Corinalona Enciu and Lomel Cosmin; and
- 2. Accuse him further for having on the same date, time, place and circumstances in any public or place open to the public, was found drunk or incapable of taking care of himself.

Seen all documentation including the Consent of the Attorney General so that

the case will be dealt with summarily; and

After seen Articles 267, 280 and 338(ff) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Upon admission of the charges by the accused and the confirmation of such charges after given the opportunity to reconsider his position, finds accused Nikola Vulenic guilty of all the charges brought against him, and upon application of Article 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta, frees him on condition that he does not commit another offence within three (3) years. Finally explained to the accused in simple words, the repercussions if such order is not complied with.
