Having seen that the accused Oleksander Halkin, holder of Ukraine passport

ET785447.

Was charged with having:

1. In the Malta International Airport and on these Islands, on the 29th July 2014 at about 13:00 hrs and in the preceding days, in Malta, by means of several acts committed by the accused even if at different times.

of several acts committed by the accused, even if at different times, which acts constitute violations of the same provisions of the law, kept any premises or had in his possession, under his control or carried

outside any premises or appurtenances any firearm or ammunition

listed in Schedule II, without a Commissioner of Police license;

2. Without a license or permit from the Commissioner, imported or brought

into or exported from Malta (Registration number 10231135 a copy

firearm of Sigheur pistol).

Seen request by the prosecution that in case of guilt, apart from inflicting the

punishment prescribed by Law, also orders the forfeiture of all the objects

exhibited in these proceedings;

Seen all documentation;

Heard examination of the accused whereby he registered a guilty plea, and

the confirmation of such plea after being given the opportunity to reconsider

his position; and

Upon seeing Articles 5(1), 5(2), 51(2) and 51(3) of Chapter 480 of the Laws of

Malta, find accused Oleksander Halkin guilty of both charges brought against

him and on the first charge he is being condemned for a fine (multa) of €700

and for the second charge he is being freed on condition that he does not to

commit another offence within six (6) months time from today, and this on the

basis of Article 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws Malta.

The Court also orders confiscation and destruction of the weapon seized and

presented in Court as DOK SM9.

Finally, explained in simple words the repercussions if such order is not

complied with.
