Kopja Informali ta' Sentenza

Having seen the accusations brought against Latif Pagiaka 31 years old son of

Pagiaka Latif and Ama, born in Karaa Togo on the 12th June 1983, residing at Via G.

Giolitti 2 Padova Italy holder of Italian card number AU 0882291;

With having on the 27th August 2014 in these islands forged, altered or

tampered with a passport, or used or had in his possession a passport which

he knew to be forged, altered or tampered with (Chap 61, Sec 5 of the Laws

of Malta)

Charged also with having on the same date, time and circumstances

committed any other kind of forgery, or have knowingly made use of any

other forged document, in the mentioned documents (Chap 9, Sec 189 of the

Laws of Malta)

Charged also with having on the same date, time and circumstances used or

had in possession any documents required for the purpose of this Act which

is forged (Chap 217, Sec 32 (1f) of the Laws of Malta);

Having heard the plea of guilt as registered by the accused in today's sitting;

Having seen the records of the case;

Finds the accused guilty as charged;

Kopja Informali ta' Sentenza

Having seen article 5 of Chapter 61, 189 of Chapter 9 and 32(1)(f) of Chapter 217 of

the Laws of Malta;

Condemns the accused to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year from today which

term shall not elapse unless the accused commits any other offence punishable with

imprisonment within a period of two (2) years from today in terms of article 28A of

Chapter 9 of the laws of Malta.

The Court explained to the accused his obligations arising out of this judgement.
