Having seen the charges brought against **Mohamed Jamal Burkey, 24** years of age, born in Tripoli on 09<sup>th</sup> Frebruary 1988, son of Jamal and Souad *nee'* Abu Grara

residing at 102 Triq il-Hemel Swieqi holder of Libyan passport number 706822

And charge him with having in these Islands on the 6<sup>th</sup> April 2012 at about quarter past six (06:00am) had in his possession (otherwise than in the course of transit through Malta of the territorial waters thereof) the resin obtained from the plant Cannabis, or any other preparation of which such resin formed the base, in terms

of Section 8 (a) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta;

Having seen the early admission of the accused;

Having heard from the Prosecution that the accused collaborated fully with them and

immediately admitted to the accusations made;

Having seen the clean conviction sheet of the accused and having seen that the accused

intends to continue his University studies in Malta;

Having seen Section 8(a) of Chapter 101, as well as Section 22(1) of Chapter 446;

Discharges the accused with the specific condition that he does not commit any other

offence within a period of one (1) year from today in terms of article 22 of Chapter 446 of

the Laws of Malta.
