

The Court,

Having seen the charges laid against the accused, holder of police number 14DB-002:

 Charged with having on the 17th March at about 1700hrs escaped from any place of confinement or of punishment, or from a hospital, where he is under treatment or observation or from custody of the person or persons charged with his custody, that is,

escaping from Mater Dei hospital, while having treatment under custody (Chapter 9, Section 151 and 152 of the Laws of Malta);

- Charged also with having committed a crime during the operational period of a suspended sentence handed by Magistrate Dr Audrey Demicoli LL.D. on the 3rd January 2014;
- 3. Charged also for being a recidivist according to Article 49 and 50 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta after being found guilty by the Maltese Courts on 3rd January 2014;

Having seen the note of the attorney General that the case be heard summarily to which the accused did not oppose;

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges brought against him;

Having seen all documents and records of the proceedings;

On the voluntary and unconditional plea of guilt of the accused on which he insisted even after having been given time to reconsider;

Declares and finds him guilty.

Having seen Article 152, 49, 50 and 28 of Chapter 9.

Decides in virtue of Article 28B of Chapter 9 to vary the terms of his suspended sentence consequently inflicting a term of imprisonment of two years suspended for four.

The Court explained to the accused his responsibilities according to the judgement.
