Informal Copy of Judgement

After seeing the charges brought against;

Enrico Armelloni of 22 yrs, son of Alfredo Silvano and Eva Manzoni, born in Italy on 14th May 1992, residint at Hostel 94, Isourd Street, Sliema and holder of Italian license number U1B970426N;

With having on the 9th August 2014 and during the previous days had in his possession (otherwise than in the course of transit through Malta of the territorial waters thereof) the whole or any portion of the plant Cannabis in terms of Section 8 (d) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta;

Considers:

After having seen Article 8(d) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta;

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited;

After having heard the accused admit the charges brought against him, which admission was confirmed by him after having been given due time to reconsider in accordance with the law; This Court finds the said accused guilty as charged, and discharges him from any punishment on condition that he does not commit another offense within the period of six (6) months, in accordance with the provisions of Article 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court furthermore orders the destruction of the substance found.

The Court explained in clear words the terms of the judgment to the accused.
