Milos Simonovic son of Zoran and Dusanka nee' Djuruvic, born in Serbia on the 24th April 1989, residing at Porto Flats, Flat 11, Sirk Street, Swieqi and holder of Serbian passport no. 010020450;

With having on the 30th August 2014 and the previous days in these islands had in his possession (otherwise than in the course of transit through Malta of the territorial waters thereof) the whole or any portion of the plant Cannabis in terms of Section 8 (d) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta;

Considers:

After having seen Article 8 (d) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta;

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited;

After having heard the accused admit the charges brought against him, which admission was confirmed by him after having been given due time to reconsider in accordance with the law;

This Court finds the said accused guilty as charged, and discharges him from

any punishment on condition that he does not commit another offence within

the period of six (6) months, in accordance with the provisions of Article 22 of

Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.
