The Court,

Having seen the charges adduced against the accused, holder of ID number 51094A, with having in Paceville or in its vicinity, on the 8th August 2014 at around 0530 hrs:

1. wilfully committed any spoil, damage or injury to or upon any movable or immovable property belonging to St Julians Local Council, which amount of damage does not exceed one thousand and one hundred and sixty-four euro and sixty-nine cents (1,164.69) but exceeds one hundred and sixteen euro and forty-seven cents (116.47);

Informal Copy of Judgement

2. assaulted or resisted by violence or active force not amounting to public violence, any person lawfully charged with a public duty (PS321 A. La Grasta) when in execution of the law or of a lawful order issued by a competent authority.
3. in any public place or place open to the public, is found drunk and incapable of taking care of himself.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges as proffered against him;

Having seen all the records and documents of the proceedings;

In virtue of the plea of guilt registered by the accused upon which he insisted even after the Court gave him time to reconsider;

Having seen Article 325 (b), 96, 338 (bb) and 17 of Chapter 9 declares and finds him guilty as charged.

Decides to apply Article 22 of Chapter 446 and acquits him for a period of one year from today on condition that he does not commit a further indictable offence within this period.

Having considered Article 24 of the said Chapter 446 condemns and orders him to refund all damages caused to the St Julians Local Council in the amount of €343 within three months from today.

The court explained to the accused his responsibilities according to the judgement.
