Informal Copy of Judgement

Having seen that the accused Griselda Reci, holder of Albanian passport number BJ4694904.

Was charged with having:

On the 7th of January 2015 or previous days in these Islands or somewhere else, forged, altered or tampered with 3 Greek Identity Cards bearing numbers AB274638, AB364702 & AB330258 or used or had in her possession same counterfeit Greek documents, which she knew to be forged, altered or tampered with;

On same date, time and circumstances committed any other kind of forgery, or have knowingly made use of any other forged document, in the mentioned documents;

On same date, time and circumstances forged any document or true copy of a document or an entry made in pursuance of this Act.

Seen all documentation including the Consent of the Attorney General so that the case will be dealt with summarily;

Seen Article 189 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, Article 5 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta and Article 32(1d) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta;

Informal Copy of Judgement

Heard guilty plea by accused and the confirmation of such plea after being

given the opportunity to reconsider his plea;

Seen that she has two minor children who are dependent on her;

Seen that she is going to be repatriated to Albania immediately; and

Upon seeing Articles of Law finds accused, Griselda Reci, guilty of all charges

and by virtue of Article 28A Chapter 9 condemns her to eight (8) months

imprisonment suspended for fifteen (15) months.

Finally explained in simple words to the accused, the repercussions if such

order is not complied with.
