Jamshid Odilov

The Court,

After having seen the charges brought against **Jamshid Odilov**, thirty (30) years old, son of Odil and Gulnara, born in Jizzakh, Uzbekistan, on the 3rd May 1984, residing at 195, Brared Street, Birkirkara, holder of Residence Permit MT8029064 and Identity Number 0057007A, accused with:

- 1. having on the 28^{th.} January 2015 in Hamrun, that is in Kuzey Kebab Shop in Qormi Road, employed or gave work to any person who was not an exempt person and was not in possession of a licence granted to him for the purpose of such employment or work under the provisions of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta;
- 2. in the same day, place and circumstances as an employer who employs another person whole-time, part-time or otherwise under a definite or indefinite contract or on probation, failed to notify the Employment and Training Corporation of such employment as stipulated in Legal Notice 110 of the year 1993 (Art. 3A to 10)

Having examined all the documents forming part of the proceedings.

Having seen that the Attorney General gave his consent for this case to be tried summarily (Doc. "MH 1" – *a fol.* 6).

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges brought against him, notwithstanding the fact that the Court in terms of Section 453(1) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta warned him in the most solemn manner of the legal consequences of his guilty plea after having given him sufficient time within which to reconsider and withdraw his guilty plea.

Considers

That, as a consequence of the admission of the accused of the charges brought against him, the Court finds the accused guilty of the said charges.

With regards to the punishment to be inflicted, the Court will be taking into consideration various factors, including the nature of the charges brought against the accused, his guilty plea at an early stage of these proceedings, his co-operation with the Police and his clean conviction sheet (Doc. "MH 2" – a *fol.* 8).

Therefore, the Court, after having seen and considered Section 32(1)(b) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta and Regulation 3(a) of Legal Notice 110 of 1993, finds the accused Jamshid Odilov guilty of the charges brought against him and condemns him to a fine (*multa*) of one thousand, one hundred and sixty-four Euros and sixty-nine cents (\in 1164.69).
