The Court:

Having seen the accusations brought against the accused Doris George.

Accused that:

Having on the 22nd of December 2014 in these islands forged, altered or tampered with ID card and Travel document, or used or had in her possession the mentioned documents which she knew to be forged, altered or tampered with, in her name bearing numbers AO5732299, L252423 and 044460 respectively;

And charge her also with having on the same date, time and circumstances forged any document or true copy of a document or an entry made in pursuance of the act.

The Court:

Read the documents and accusations;

Heard the evidence produced under oath;

After having seen Chapter 61, Section 5 of the Laws of Malta and Chapter 217, Section 32 (1) (d) of the Laws of Malta;

The Court after taking in consideration the admission of the accused;

For these reasons and in terms of Article 28 A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, and after having due consideration towards the circumstances of the case, this Court condemns the accused Doris George of a term of imprisonment of one (1) year but is ordering that this sentence should not be carried out unless the accused is found guilty of another offence which carries a term of imprisonment for the next two (2) years.

The Court explained the consequences of the judgement to the accused.
