ABDIAZIZ HASSAN IBRAHIM

The Court:

Having seen the accusations brought against the accused Abdiaziz Hassan Ibrahim, holder of identity card number 82359A.

Accused that:

On the 23rd November, 2014, at about quarter to two in the morning (01:45hrs) at St. George's Road, St. Julian's:

1. Committed theft of handbag with various items inside, to the detriment of Ms. Leah Bugeja from B'Bugia, which amount accedes two hundred thirty two euro and ninety four cents (€232.94) but does not accede two thousand three hundred twenty nine euro and thirty seven cents (€2,329.37), which theft is aggravated by amount and time.

The Court:

Read the documents and accusations;

Heard the evidence produced under oath;

After having seen Articles 261, 267, 271 and 279 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Considers:

The Court after having seen the plea of the accused and after having seen his reconsideration of this plea, considers that the voluntary admission of the accused to the charges brought against him by the Prosecution leaves this Court with no other alternative but to find the accused guilty as charged.

For these reasons and in terms of Article 28 A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, and after having due consideration towards the circumstances of the case, this Court condemns the accused Abdiaziz Hassan Ibrahim of a term of imprisonment of one (1) year but is ordering that this sentence should not be carried out unless the accused is found guilty of another offence which carries a term of imprisonment for the next two (2) years.

The Court explained the consequences of the judgement to the accused.
