The Court:

Having seen the accusations brought against the accused Abduljalil Abubakri, holder of Italian Aliens Passport number 122900.

Accused that:

Having on the 23rd November, 2014, or previous days in these islands forged, altered or tampered with documents or used or had in his possession forged documents, which he knew to be forged, altered or tampered with, that is had in his possession Italian Residence permit bearing number I4039418, Italian passport for Aliens bearing number 044465 and Italian ID card bearing number AS8820788;

And charge him also with having on same date, time and circumstances committed any other kind of forgery, or have knowingly made use of any other forged document, that is with regards to the mentioned documents;

And charge him also with having on same date, time and circumstances forged any document or true copy of a document or an entry made in pursuance of this act.

The Court:

Read the documents and accusations;

Heard the evidence produced under oath;

After having seen Chapter 61, section 5 of the Laws of Malta and Chapter 9, Section 189 of the Laws of Malta and also Chapter 217, Section 32 (1d) of the Laws of Malta.

Considers:

The Court after having seen the plea of the accused and after having seen his reconsideration of this plea, considers that the voluntary admission of the accused to the charges brought against him by the Prosecution leaves this Court with no other alternative but to find the accused guilty as charged.

For these reasons and in terms of Article 28 A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, and after having due consideration towards the circumstances of the case, this Court condemns the accused Abduljalil Abubakri of a term of imprisonment of one (1) year but is ordering that this sentence should not be carried out unless the accused is found guilty of another offence which carries a term of imprisonment for the next year (1).

The Court orders the destruction of the exhibited documents.

The Court explained the consequences of the judgement to the accused.
