Callum Paul Wright holder of British Passport No 509579696;

The Court;

Having seen charges proffered against the above-mentioned Callum Paul Wright who was charged of having on the 3rd April, 2015 and the previous days on these Islands:

- 1. Supplied or distributed, or offered to supply or distribute dangerous drugs (Ecstasy), being a drug restricted and controlled under the provisions of the Kindred and medical Profession ordinance to person/s, who are not authorised person/s or for the use of other person/s, without being Fully authorised in breach of the Medical nad Kindred Profession Ordinance Chapter 31 of the Laws of Malta and the Drugs (Control) Regulations, Legal Notice 22 of 1985 as amended;
- 2. Supplied or distributed, or offered to supply or distribute dangerous drugs (MDMA), being a drug restricted and controlled under the provisions of the Kindred and medical Profession ordinance to person/s, who are not authorised person/s or for the use of other person/s, without being Fully authorised in breach of the Medical nad Kindred Profession Ordinance Chapter 31 of the Laws of Malta and the Drugs (Control) Regulations, Legal Notice 22 of 1985 as amended;
- 3. Supplied or distributed, or offered to supply or distribute dangerous drugs (Ketamine), being a drug restricted and controlled under the provisions of the Kindred and medical Profession ordinance to person/s, who are not authorised person/s or for the use of other person/s, without being Fully authorised in breach of the Medical nad Kindred Profession Ordinance Chapter 31 of the Laws of Malta and the Drugs (Control) Regulations, Legal Notice 22 of 1985 as amended;
- 4. Committed these offences in, or within 100 metres of the perimeter of, a school, youth club or centre, or such other place where young people habitually meet in breach of Article 22 (2) of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta.

Seen that accused chose to enter a guilty plea and confirmed the same after been given time to reconsider same.

Seen the Orders issued by Attorney General under Chapters 31 and 101 of the Laws of Malta.

Finds the accused guilty as charged, after having seen Sections 40A and 120A of Chapter 31 of the Laws of Malta; Sections 22(2) and 22(2)(b) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta; Legal Notice 22/1985, and condemns him to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year and to a fine of five hundred Euros (€500).

Orders the destruction of the drugs exhibited, as also the forfeiture of the monies exhibited.
