Informal Copy of Judgement

Having seen that the accused Mohamed Konteh

Was charged with having on the night of the 25th July 2015 at Paceville St Julian's:

- 1. Produced, sold or otherwise dealt in the resin obtained from the plant cannabis or any preparation of which such resin formed the base, in terms of Section 8(b) or Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta;
- 2. Committed these offences in, or within 100 meters of the perimeter of, a school, youth club or centre, or such other place where young people habitually meet in breach of Article 22(2) of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta.

Seen the request of the prosecution so that when pronouncing judgment or in any subsequent order, to sentence the person convicted, to the payment, wholly or in part, to the registrar, of the costs incurred in connection with the employment in the proceedings of any expert or referee, including – such experts as would have been appointed in the examination of the process

verbal of the inquiry, within such period and in such amount as shall be

determined in the judgment or order.

Heard guilty plea by accused and the confirmation of such plea after being

given the opportunity to reconsider his plea;

Upon having seen Article 8(b), 22(2), 22(2)(b) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of

Malta, finds accused Mohamed Konteh guilty of charges brought against him

and condemns him to one (1) year imprisonment together with a fine (multa)

of five hundred Euro (€500).
