The Court

Having seen the charges brought against **Abdurahman Yousuf Adam** holder of police number 12I-047.

Charged with having, in September 2013 and in the months before or after, as a person landing or embarking in Malta, failed to furnish the Principal Immigration Officer the prescribed information and such other information that the Principal Immigration Officer may deem proper to require.

Having seen section 28 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Having heard the defendant admit the charge brought against him.

Having seen the documents filed by the prosecuting officer.

Having heard the submissions regarding the penalty to be meted out.

Having considered

That defendant admitted the charge brought against him; this is consequently sufficiently proven.

With regards the penalty to be meted out the Court took into consideration the nature of the offence of which defendant is being found guilty on the one hand and on the other hand his cooperation with the police, his admission at the earliest stage of these proceedings and his clean conviction sheet.

Wherefore, the Court after having seen section 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta, on his admission finds defendant guilty of the charge brought against him and condemns him to two months imprisonment.
