COURT OF MAGISTRATES (MALTA) AS A COURT OF CRIMINAL JUDICATURE

The Court,

Having seen the charge brought against the accused Leilei Liao, Chinese national, born on the 02 January 1988 in Sichuan China, son of Liao Xue and He Cai Yun, residing at 40, China House, Triq Hal Far, Birzebbugia or Leisure Clothing Bulebel, and, holder of Maltese Resident Permit MT8278147 and Chinese Passport G57654958 and mobile number 99288976 that on the 14th March 2015 at about 15:15hrs at the Malta International Airport

Entered, with or without a vehicle, into any part of a restricted area without the permission of the Head Aviation Security, and the authority responsible for the air navigation installation or a person acting on behalf of that Head or authority, and in accordance with any conditions subject to which that permission is for the time being granted.

Having seen all the acts and documents exhibited;

Having heard witnesses.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charge brought against him, notwithstanding the fact that the Court warned him in the most solemn manner of the legal consequences of his guilty plea after having given him sufficient time within which to reconsider and withdraw his guilty plea;

Considers:

Having heard the guilty plea of the accused to the charge brought against him the Court has no alternative but to declare the accused guilty of the charge brought against him.

With regards to punishment the Court took into consideration the fact that the accused pleaded guilty at an early stage of the proceedings and his clean record sheet.

In view of the above, the Court, after having seen article 11(1a), 12(1) and 17(1) of Chapter 405 of the Laws of Malta, upon admission finds the accused guilty of the charge brought against him and condemns him to pay a fine of two thousand three hundred and twenty-nine Euro and thirty-seven euro cents(€2,329.37). The accused is being given one year to pay such fine in monthly installments. If such amount or part of it is not paid, then such fine or the balance which remains to be paid is to be converted into imprisonment.
