The Court,

Having seen that the accused Mahad Abdi Creem of 23 years of Somalia nationality son of Mahad and Tora born in Mogadishu on the 01/01/1992 residing at an unknown address, holder of police number 13N-063

Was charged with having on the 14th November, 2015, inside is-Salib Street, Marsa-

1. Wilfully committed any spoil, damage or injury to or upon any movable or immovable property belonging to any other person, namely Laurence Brincat from Marsa, of which amount of damage does not exceed two hundred and fifty euro (250), and this is in violation of article 325(c) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

2. Under the same date, place, and circumstances he disobeyed the lawful orders of any authority or of any person, entrusted with a public service, or hindered or obstructed such person in the exercise of his duties, or otherwise unduly interfered with the exercise of such duties, either by preventing other persons from doing what they are lawfully enjoined or allowed to do, or frustrating or undoing what has been lawfully done by other persons, or in any other manner. And this in violation of article 338(ee) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

3. Under the same date, place, time and circumstances, in any public place or place open to the public, was found drunk and incapable of taking care of himself. And this in violation of article 338(ff) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Heard the accused pleading guilty to all the charges brought against him and seen that such admission was given at the outset of the proceedings.

Finds accused Rahad Abdi Creem guilty of the charges brought against him and buy virtue of Article 28A Chapter 9 condemns him to one (1) year imprisonment suspended for two (2) years.

The Court also orders accused to pay Laurence Brincat the sum of $\notin 80$ within six (6) months from today and this as the basis of Article 28H of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.
