Kamel Ibrahim

Today the 17th November, 2015,

The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the Kamel Ibrahim, holder of passport number 08PC89016 and charged with having:

On the 16th November, 2014 and or in the previous days in these islands forged, altered or tampered with an Italian *permesso di soggiorno* or document, or used or had in his possession an Italian *permesso di soggiorno* card or document, which he knew to be forged, altered or tampered.

And charge him with also having on same date, time and circumstances committed any other kind of forgery, or have knowingly made use of any other forged document, in the mentioned documents.

And charge him also with having on same date, time and circumstances without lawful authority used or had in his possession any document required for the purposes of this Act which is forged;

Having seen the acts of the proceedings;

Having heard that on the 16th November, 2015, the accused registered a guilty plea, and confirmed such admission even after the Court gave him time to consider such plea.

Having heard that the prosecution that the accused is going to be immediately deported elsewhere.

Having seen section 5 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta, section 189 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, section 32(1f) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

For this reason the Court finds accused Kamel Ibrahim guilty of all the charges brought against him and convicts him to a term of imprisonment of one year, which term by virtue of Article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta is suspended for two (2) years.
